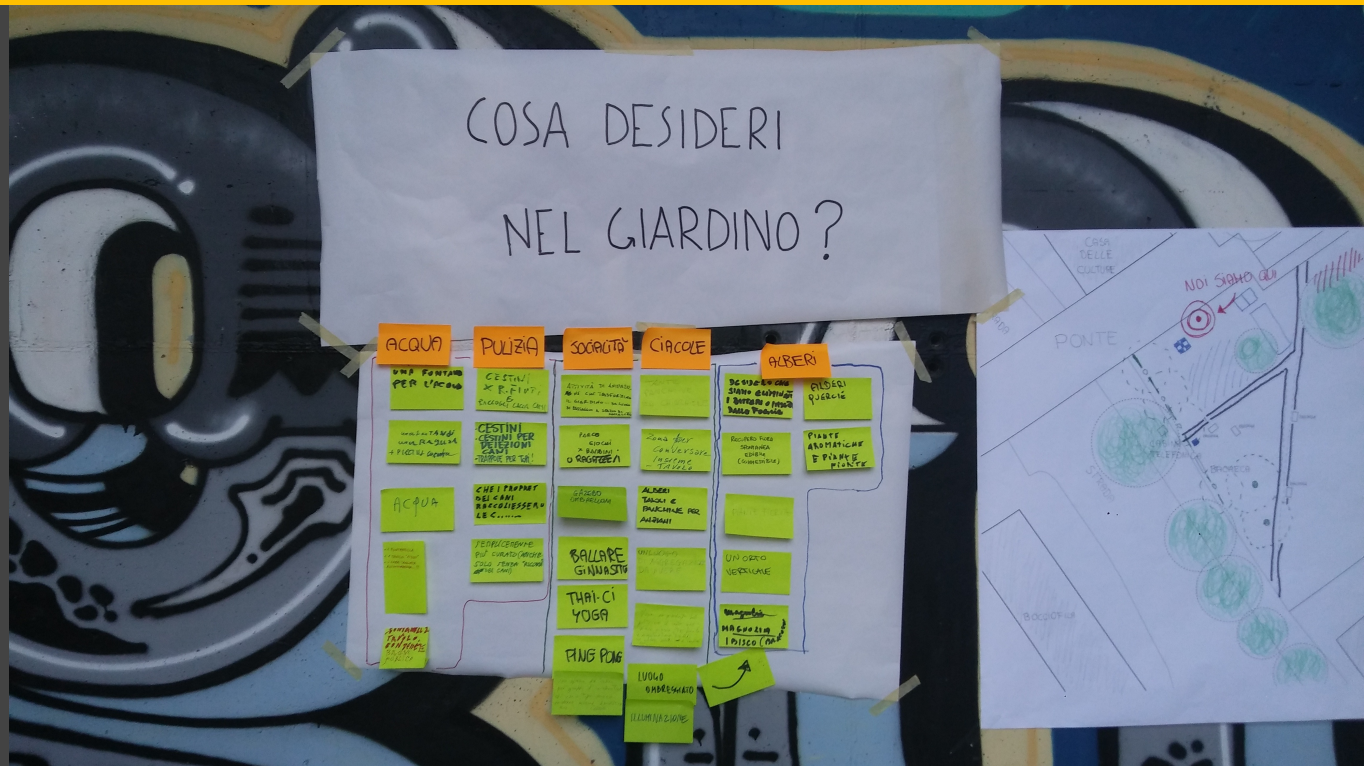

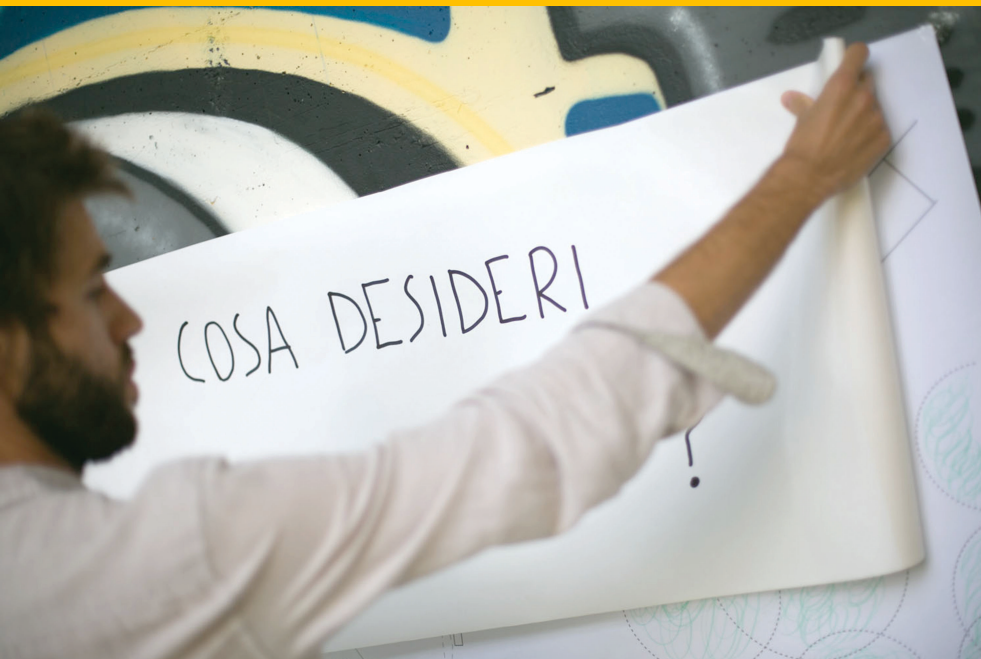

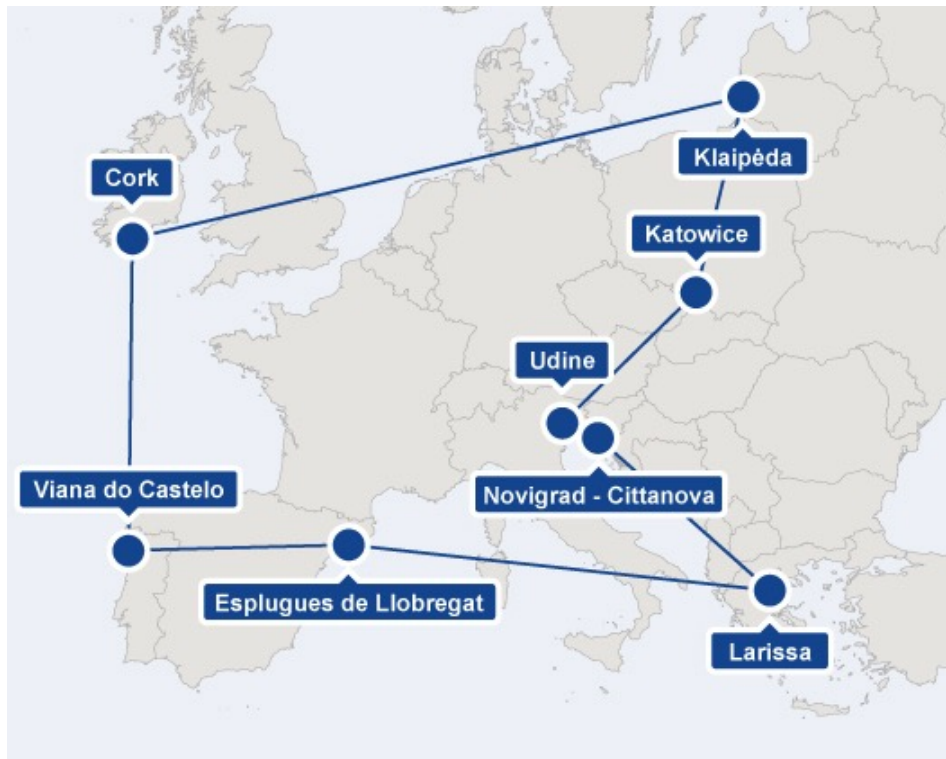




# PLAYFUL PARADIGM

# Why a long time history of Play in Udine



Udine started **20 years ago** in promoting Play as flexible and innovative tool to tackle urban challenges and promoting healthy and sustainable lifestyle.







## The Ludobus experience: including the peripheries in the city centre by play!

In Udine the first building block to build the infrastructure of PLAY was the [Ludobus](#), a **mobile toy-library** used to promote play activities during summertime both in the suburbs and in the city centre.



# Infrastructures are not enough!

An office of play was established by the Municipality of Udine with a dedicated staff uncharged to coordinate the Ludobus and Toy-library activities, promote the permanent “play education” for schools and other institutions, organise the numerous playful events and boost always novel play initiatives

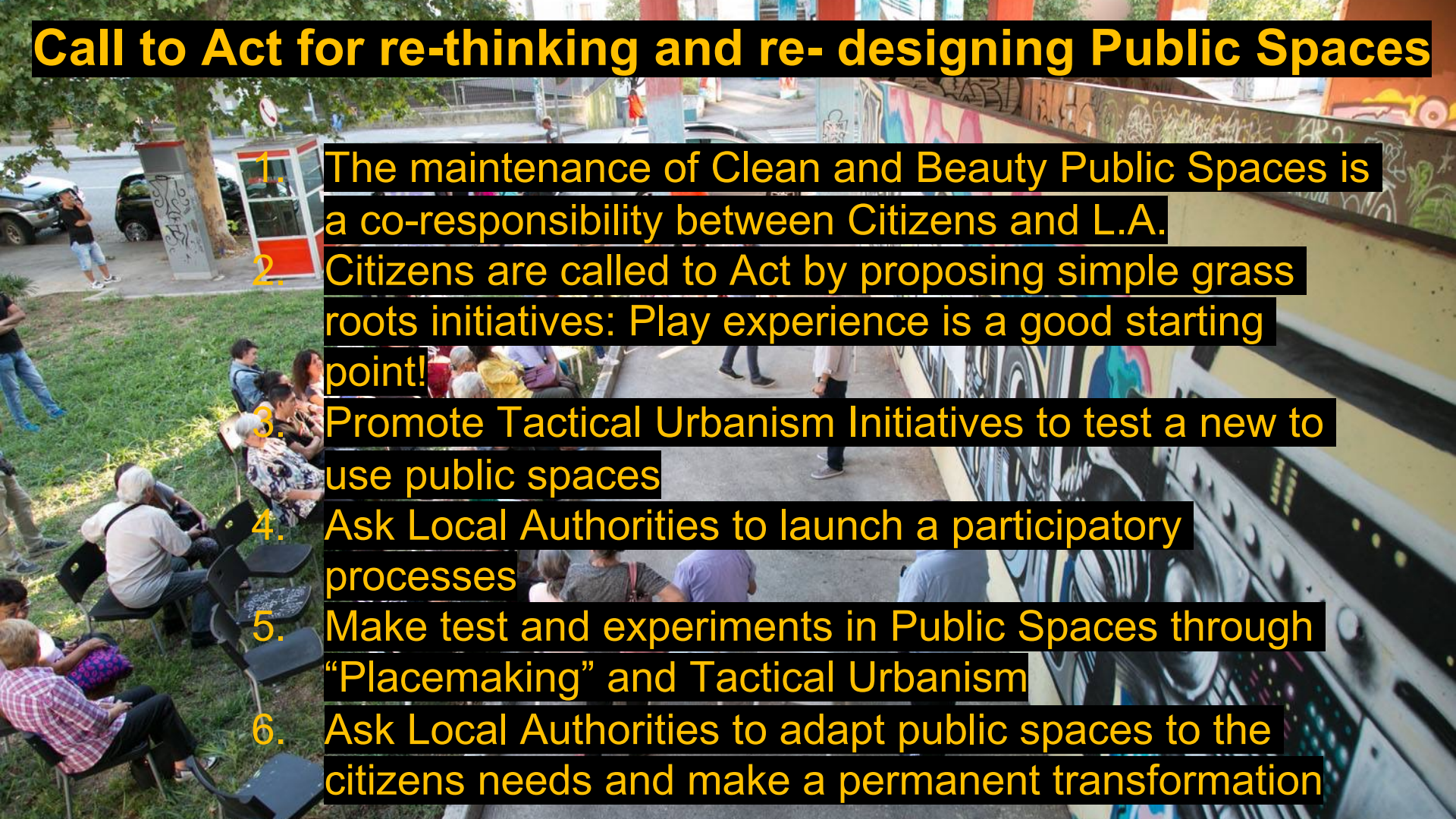

# Call to Act for re-thinking and re- designing Public Spaces

1. The maintenance of Clean and Beauty Public Spaces is a co-responsibility between Citizens and L.A.
2. Citizens are called to Act by proposing simple grass roots initiatives: Play experience is a good starting point!
3. Promote Tactical Urbanism Initiatives to test a new to use public spaces
4. Ask Local Authorities to launch a participatory processes
5. Make test and experiments in Public Spaces through “Placemaking” and Tactical Urbanism
6. Ask Local Authorities to adapt public spaces to the citizens needs and make a permanent transformation
